The images in this set were created to help facilitate simple role plays in English. In certain cultures the language of complaining is highly frowned upon and it could be difficult for some people to effectively use polite complaints in necessary situations. This worksheet helps students produce language clearly and carefully by giving them the situations in the restaurant for them to complain about. It's up to you the teacher to be sure that they are provided the appropriate language for doing that.

Note: Kids have a way of destroying cards they get hold of, so after printing the cards you might want to laminate them and remember to round off the edges so no one gets a sharp card in the eye. If you do it well enough this opens up the usage of the cards for a few good games where you can flick or flip the cards to be more active.

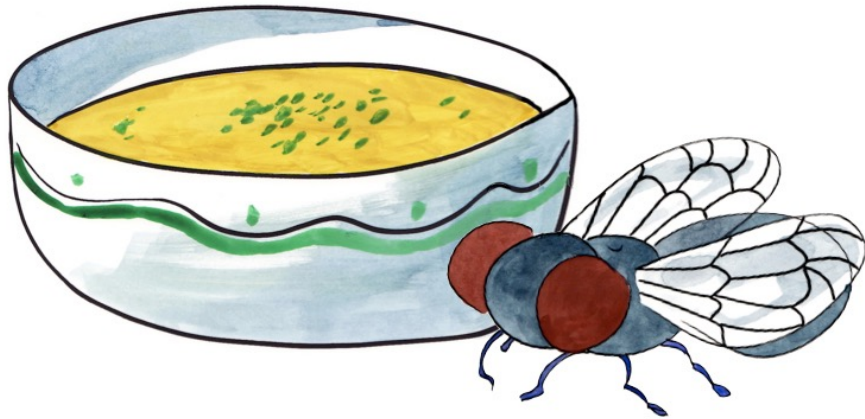

There's a fly in my food!



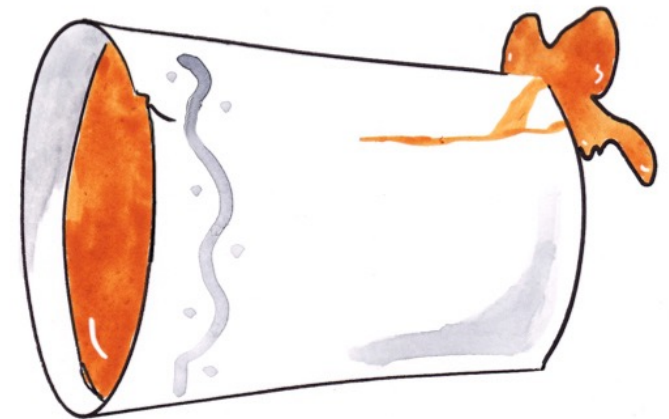
This spoon is dirty!

This cup is leaking!



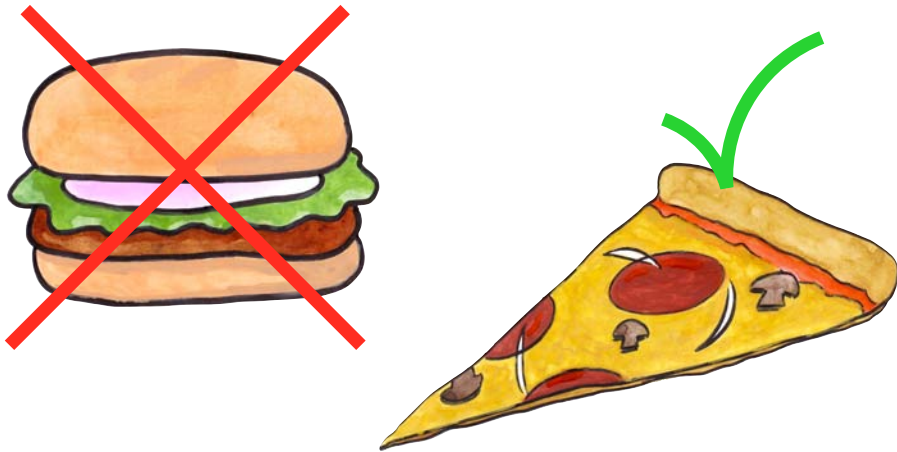
I saw a rat under a table!
