

He's a ... / She's a ...

This is a super simple set of images used for really little kids. It's a good way to help them use gender words to talk about individuals. These terms are going to get used again and again and again so the high frequency means they are always valuable and the simplicity means even little ones (like my two-year old) can understand them.

Lots of little kids studying English as a second language will simply say a short word or two like "teacher" or "doctor!" Thee images make it easy to get the little ones making full, simple sentences "He's a teacher," "She's a doctor!"

Don't worry about the contractions.

A. Kids don't know or care, they'll just say it.

B. It's not natural to say "He is a ... "

C. He's a teacher. = three units. He is a teacher = four units. So the first is easier.

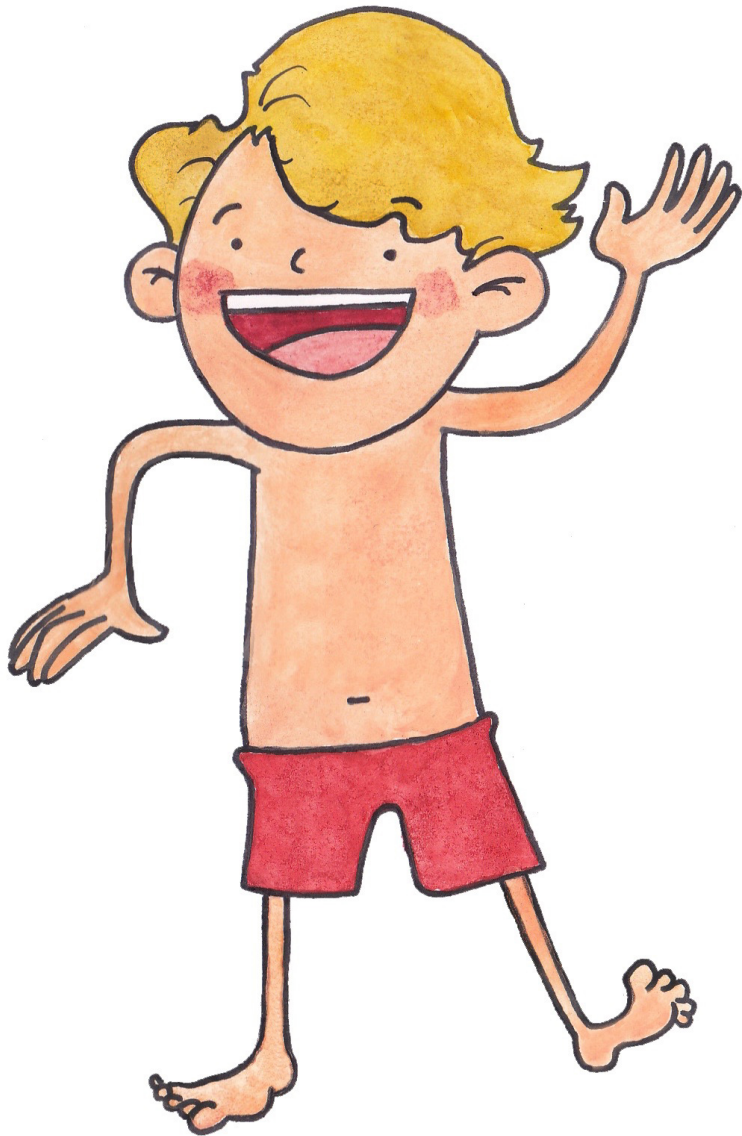
It helps for kids to know the meaning but at the level we're talking about here it's just about making simple sentences.

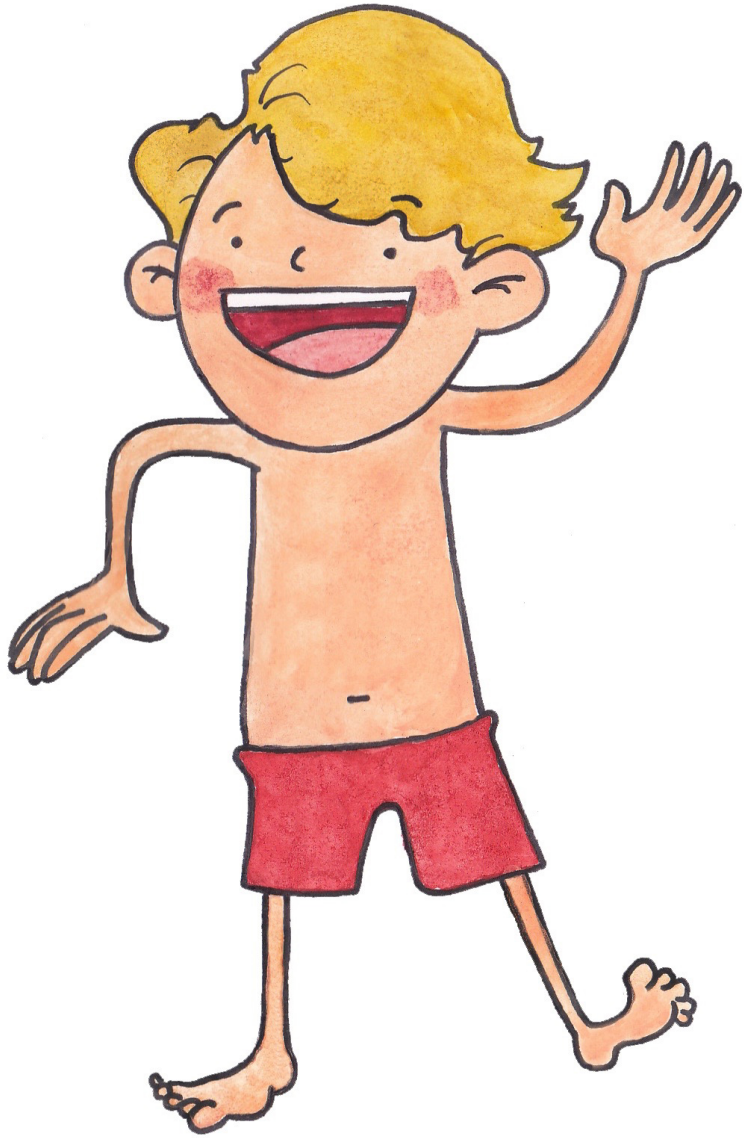

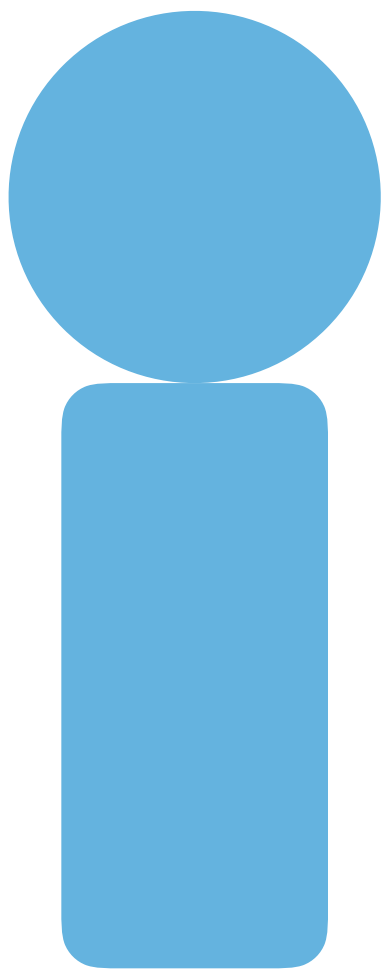
