

Replacement Drills

One-word

TS: I'm going to go **shopping**.
T: **shopping**.
S: I'm going to go shopping.
T: **sightseeing**
S: I'm going to go sightseeing.
T: **swimming**
S: I'm going to go swimming.

Multiple-word:

TS: I'm going to go **snowboarding** in **Nagano**.
T: **snowboarding / Nagano**
S: I'm going to go snowboarding in Nagano.
T: **jogging / in the park**
S: I'm going to go jogging in the park.
T: **swimming / at the beach**
S: I'm going to go swimming at the beach.

Fragments A

TS: Have you ever **been to Egypt**?
T: **been to Egypt?**
S: Have you ever been to Egypt?
T: **eaten sushi?**
S: Have you ever eaten sushi?
T: **seen a ghost?**
S: Have you ever seen a ghost?

Fragments B

TS: I've never **seen anything** like that.
T: **seen anything**
S: I've never seen anything like that.
T: **met anyone**
S: I've never met anyone like that.
T: **gone anywhere**
S: I've never gone anywhere like that.

Clauses A

TS: I don't know **who he is**.
T: **who he is**
S: I don't know who he is.
T: **where it is**
S: I don't know where it is.
T: **when it starts**
S: I don't know when it starts.

Clauses B

TS: Give me a call **when it starts**.
T: **when it starts**
S: Give me a call when it starts.
T: **when she gets here**
S: Give me a call when she gets here.
T: **when you're ready**
S: Give me a call when you're ready.

Longer Phrases A

TS: I **went out** for the first time **in a while**.
T: **went out / in a while**
S: I went out for the first time in a while.
T: **bought jeans / this year**
S: I bought jeans for the first time this year.
T: **exercised / this week**
S: I exercised for the first time this week.

Longer Phrases B

TS: He was the **first person** to **win in a while**.
T: **first person / win / while**
S: He was the first person to win in a while.
T: **last person / finish / last year**
S: He was the last person to finish last year.
T: **second girl / sign up / yesterday**
S: She was the second girl to sign up yesterday.
