About the cards

For once on My English Images there are NO IMAGES! Let's face it, image are great but we don't ALWAYS need them and honestly if we did it would be boring. In this case, the activity just doesn't require having a bunch of pictures. In fact this five minute review should be done as quickly as possible in order to facilitate students getting back to some conversation where they might actually have a chance to USE these words. So don't get hung up on the lack of images and just get it done.

Who is this sheet for?

These cards are for any students who need a quick review in order to help them get over repeated mistakes in using the words in, on and at for time. It's a simple categorizing activity that can be done as a review or a warm up and can even be used multiple times multiple ways.

Using the cards

There are countless ways to use cards in classes. Games of memory, matching games, and games where kids run to the card or throw the card into a hat for a point. As long as you are active and fun and the kids are enjoying themselves you're going to have a great time and they are too. Make sure you and your students say the words again and again and speak, make sentences so everyone can hear and say the sentences in context.

Note: Kids have a way of destroying cards they get hold of, so after printing the cards you might want to laminate them and remember to round off the edges so no one gets a sharp card in the eye. If you do it well enough this opens up the usage of the cards for a few good games where you can flick or flip the cards to be more active.
