

Clock BINGO! 2

Bingo is a fun kids' game and there are about a billion variations you can play. I've made this worksheet to focus on telling time; specifically for telling the quarter hour. As a result I haven't included any of the exact hours. All you'll find here are times like 12:15, 30 and 45. I've also switched from an analog clock to a digital one in this version because the focus is the language and the numbers not actually reading the clock itself. With full hours I don't mind using the analog clock. Also it would have taken too long to actually make the analog clock for the quarter hours.

Using the game:

Try to work some numbers up to 12 into your lesson early on. Then have them run through the times with a clock, reading out a big loud O! CLOCK! (I laminated my sheet so I can reused them again and again.) After that, play the game with glass beads as counters or whatever else works for you. The kids will love it.
